INSIDE INFORMATION LITIGATION

This announcement is made by Culturecom Holdings Limited (the "Company") pursuant to Rule 13.09(2) of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited ("Listing Rules") and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined in the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

Reference is made to the announcement of the Company dated 30 November 2020 (the "Announcement"). The same abbreviations and definitions adopted in the Announcement are used in this announcement unless stated otherwise.

On 15 September 2021, the Summons and a further summons taken out by the Plaintiffs on 16 December 2020 (collectively "the Summonses") to apply for interlocutory injunctive relief against Jade Dynasty Publications Limited ("1st Defendant"), Apex Print Limited ("2nd Defendant"), Tung Tak Newspaper & Magazine Agency Company Limited ("3rd Defendant"), Lam Ching Tak trading as Collector's Comics Zone ("4th Defendant") and Mr. Huang Yulang (also known as 黃玉郎)("5th Defendant") (collectively known as the "Defendants") were heard before The Honourable Mr. Justice Lok (the "Hearing"). At the Hearing, the Court made an order (the "Order") that (inter alia):

- 1. The Defendants and each of them, whether acting by themselves, their affiliates, directors, officers, employees, servants, agents, representatives, associated companies, subsidiaries or any of them or otherwise howsoever, be restrained until after judgment in this Action or any further order from;
 - (a) Making, producing, publishing, selling, supplying, distributing, issuing to the public, promoting, marketing, advertising, and/or otherwise howsoever dealing in or with:—
 - (i) any copy of Issue No.1 of the "小流氓" comic books ("Little Rascals Comics") included in Exhibit "KKC-3" to the 1st Affirmation of Kwan Kin Chung filed on 16 December 2020 (the "Kwan 1st Affirmation");

- (ii) any copy of Issue No.2 of the Little Rascals Comics included in Exhibit "KKC-3" to the Kwan 1st Affirmation;
- (iii) any copy of Issue No.3 of the Little Rascals Comics included in Exhibit "KKC-3" to the Kwan 1st Affirmation;
- (iv) any copy of Issue No.4 of the Little Rascals Comics included in Exhibit "KKC-3" to the Kwan 1st Affirmation;
- (v) any copy of the 正宗小流氓封面集 exhibited as Exhibit "KKC-85" to the Kwan 1st Affirmation;
- (vi) any copy of Issues No.1 to 8 of the Little Rascals Comics exhibited as Exhibit "KKC-87" to the Kwan 1st Affirmation;
- (vii) any unlicensed copy or any unlicensed copy of any substantial part of any cover of Issues Nos.1 to 98 of the Little Rascals Comics; and/or
- (viii) any unlicensed copy or any unlicensed copy of any substantial part of any issue of the Little Rascals Comics;
- (b) Producing, publishing, selling, supplying, distributing, promoting, marketing, advertising, using and/or otherwise howsoever dealing in or with any products, in particular, books, magazines, newsletters, comic strips, posters, stickers, under and/or by reference to the 1st Plaintiff's registered trade mark "【记》(Trade Mark No. 2001B00169AA)("Registered Trade Mark") and/or the name or sign "小流氓" ("the Sign"), and/or any sign or name which is identical or confusingly similar to the Registered Mark and/or the Sign;
- (c) Making any representation through whatever means that the 5th Defendant or anyone other than the 1st Plaintiff is the owner of the copyright and/or other intellectual property rights subsisting in and relating to the Little Rascals Comics; and/or
- (d) Authorising, causing, enabling, assisting, counselling, instigating, inciting, enticing, procuring, aiding or abetting others to commit any of the aforesaid acts or participating in any of the aforesaid acts.
- 2. Each of the Defendants shall, within 14 days from the date of personal service of this Order upon them, deliver up to the Plaintiffs' solicitors for safekeeping, all articles, documents, goods and materials (including but not limited to comics, magazines, books, signboards, advertisements, circulars, notepaper, business cards, letter heads, stationery labels, packaging materials or other printed matters) in the possession, custody, power or control of the Defendants or any of them, the continued making, producing, publishing, marketing, promoting, advertising, disposal, sale, supply, issuing to the public, distribution or retention of which or otherwise dealing in or with which by the Defendants or any of them would offend the injunction in Paragraph 1 hereinabove.

- 3. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Defendants and each of them shall, within 14 days from the date of personal service of this Order upon them, make (in the case of the 1st to 3rd Defendants by its authorised director) and file an affirmation/affidavit (and serve a copy thereof on the Plaintiffs' solicitors), confirming that each of them have duly and fully complied with Paragraph 2 hereinabove and Paragraph 2 of their undertakings given to the Court on 27 November 2020 and set out in the Order of The Hon. Mr. Justice K. Yeung dated 27 November 2020.
- 4. The 5th Defendant shall, within 14 days from the date of personal service of this Order upon him, make and file an affirmation/affidavit (and serve a copy thereof on the Plaintiffs' solicitors), confirming that he has duly and fully complied with Paragraph 2 hereinabove and Paragraph 2 of his undertakings given to the Court on 23 December 2020 and set out in the Order of The Hon. Mr. Justice Lok dated 23 December 2020.
- 5. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 5th Defendants and each of them shall, within 14 days from the date of personal service of this Order upon them, make (in the case of the 1st to 3rd Defendant by its authorised director) and file an affidavit/affirmation (and serve a copy thereof on the Plaintiffs' solicitors), setting forth the names and contact information (including in particular addresses) of all persons, firms or companies:—
 - (a) to whom the Defendant making the affidavit/affirmation has sold, supplied, or offered for sale or supply;
 - (b) from whom the Defendant making the affidavit/affirmation has ordered, purchased and/or obtained supplies of; and/or
 - (c) who has offered to sell or supply to the Defendant making the affidavit/affirmation;

any items of the type set out in Paragraph 1(a) and (b) hereinabove together with the full details of the respective dates of such acts and do disclose in the said affidavit/ affirmation the exact whereabouts of any person, firm or company known or believed by the Defendant making the affidavit/affirmation to be in possession of any such items and further do exhibit to such affidavit/ affirmation copies of all documents relevant to the aforesaid acts (including but not limited to the contracts, purchase orders, invoices, payment receipts, correspondence, emails and delivery notes) in the possession, power, custody or control of the Defendant making the affidavit/affirmation.

6. The Plaintiffs be at liberty to use any affidavit/affirmation, document, article or information obtained in accordance with or as a result of this Order in any manner that should be required for the protection or further protection of the rights of the Plaintiffs in Hong Kong or elsewhere.

If the Defendants neglect to obey or disobey the Order, they may be held to be in contempt of Court and liable to process of execution to compel them to obey it.

Further announcements will be made to update on the progress of the matter as and when appropriate.

Shareholders and potential investors are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the securities of the Company.
